Statistics cookies

Cookie name	Cookie purpose	Expiry
_ga	registers a unique ID to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website	2 years
_gat	used by Google to manage visit rates	End of browser session
_gid	registers a unique ID to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website	End of browser session

Marketing cookies

Cookie name	Cookie purpose	Expiry
Collect	Sends data to Google Analytics about the visitor's device and behaviour	End of browser session

These cookies provide anonymous data which helps us better understand how visitors use our website. This data is used to compile reports and to help us improve the site. The cookies collect data which includes the number of visitors to the website, where the visitors have come to the website from and the pages they visited.
